

Color a Rhymes

Student Objective:

Students listen to the pre-recorded "color a rhyme" recording. As they listen, they color the rhyme.

Materials and Resources:

- CD Player or Cassette Player
- Cassette with Pre-recorded Directions
- Color a Rhyme Recording Sheet: <http://www.jmeacham.com/erase.htm>
- Crayons, Color Pencils, or Markers
- Books Relating to Color-A-Rhyme Topic

When and How to Introduce the Task:

After we do a few color a rhymes as a whole class, using the cassette player, I share with students that they can now do this activity on their own when they visit the Listening Corner.

To introduce color a rhymes to the children, I model . . .

- how to select a color a rhyme,
- how to set up your work space,
- how to insert the cassette tape,
- how to push play/rewind/stop,
- how to listen and follow directions, and
- how to return the materials to the correct locations when finished.
