

B.E.E. is an acronym for
Bring Everything Everyday.



This 3-ring binder houses EVERYTHING students and parents need to keep up-to-date with what is going on at school.

Gone are the days of wrinkled papers and lost notes, newsletters, or calendars. No more searching the house to find paper in order to write a note to school. Everything you need is in one notebook!

BEE books are important! They help students to establish good organizational skills - - - - - skills that can carry on throughout their time in school.

<p>Money and Notes Pouch</p>	<p>This pencil pouch will house notes "for the teacher" and notes "for parents" -- it is also an ideal place to put money for book orders, lunch, milk, and field trips.</p>
<p>2-Pocket Folder</p>	<p>Newsletters, school notes, field trip permission slips, homework, and monthly calendars, will be placed the 2-pocket folder. The hands located on the folder's pockets indicate if the paperwork is to be filled out and brought "RIGHT Back To School" or if it needs to be "LEFT At Home."</p>
<p>Homework Pouch</p>	<p>From time to time, your child will take a book home to read, or will need to complete homework. Homework items will be placed in the pocket folder (side loading, see through). Books should be returned the very next school day. Books that are lost or not returned <u>will result</u> in a \$5.00 (per book) fee.</p>
<p>Contacts Page</p>	<p>Ways to contact me and other staff members will be shared on the contacts page. Please keep the contact's page in the Bee book. It will be updated, if necessary, during the course of the year.</p>
<p>Book It Page</p>	<p>Your student will be given the opportunity to participate in the Book It program. If your family chooses to participate, the monthly goal and record keeping sheet will be kept in a plastic sheet protector, in the BEE Book.</p>
<p>Class List and Schedule</p>	<p>A class list and schedule will be kept in a plastic sheet protector for you to reference, when needed. Our specialists, lunch, and recess times are indicated on the schedule.</p>
<p>ABC Chart and Star Words</p>	<p>Everyday your child will participate in our shared reading of the alphabet chart. Your child will also learn many high frequency words in Kindergarten. We call these words "Star Words." An ABC Chart and listing of <i>Star Words</i> is including in the BEE book for review at home.</p> <p>☞ At-home practice is highly beneficial (and recommended).</p>
