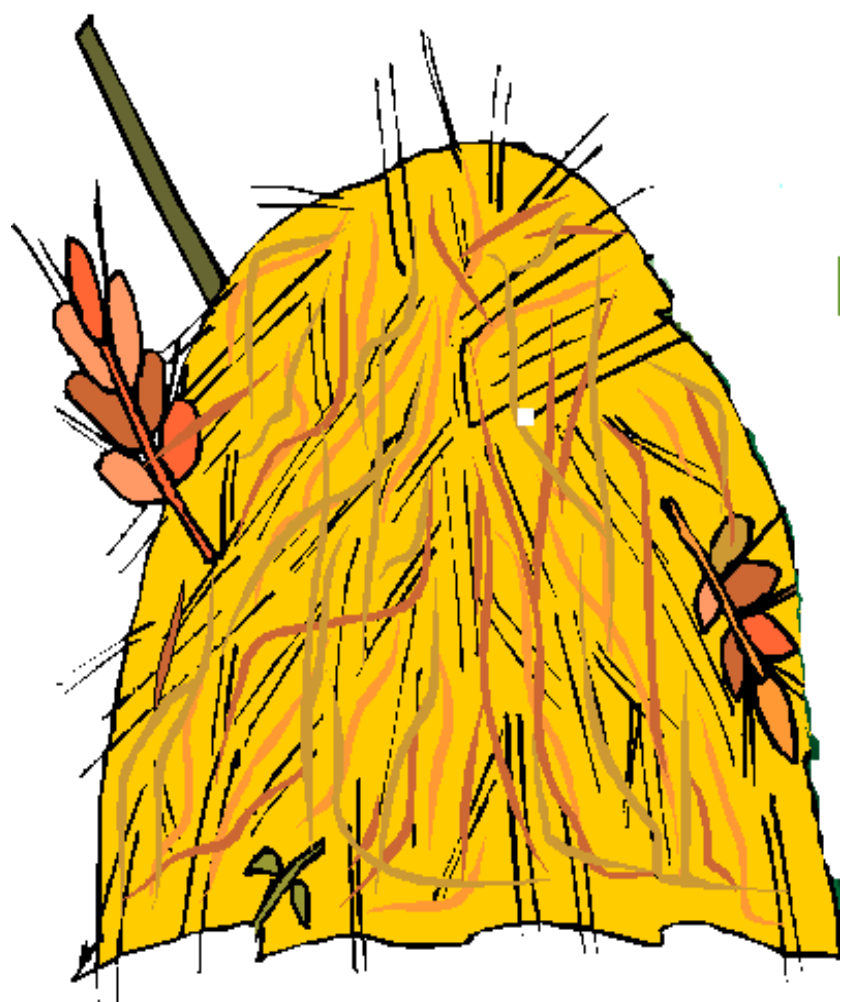

You'll need the Build-A-Turkey Stickers from Oriental Trading. When you order, you need to order enough so that each child has TWO sets of stickers! One set will be used for "body parts," and the other set will be used to make the fully assembled turkey on the last page.

Each page is duplicated so that you can copy/collate at the same time, then just cut them in half and staple.

On the feather page, the child puts the correct colored feather in the indicated place. (Red feather goes on the word RED.) Then put each of the other body parts on the correct page.

Make a fully assembled turkey on the "hiding page." The kids will have to build him tail first, then position body and other parts on top of the tail feathers.

Give each child a haystack to cut out. If you've printed it in black/white, I think you could have them color the haystack with a yellow marker and it would still look OK. Tape or staple it like a flap over the turkey on the last page. Some of the feathers will stick out the sides!! The turkey is supposed to be hiding behind the haystack, and oink-ing to confuse the potential diners!
